Now we are delighted to say that BHASVIC (Brighton, Hove and Sussex Sixth Form College) have asked to join S7 and we have been very pleased to agree. BHASVIC is a large and outstanding college on the south coast, which has been associated with S7 for a long time, as they have been sending delegates to our Leadership Programme for many years. They have been so impressed with our training and sharing of good practice opportunities that they have decided to become full members of the consortium.

Gaining two colleges recently has been such a positive injection into S7, that we were only too happy to take on another college. We can learn so much from each other and already the meetings are more vibrant and the different procedures and ideas brought to us from BHASVIC are very beneficial and interesting to us all. We hope that they will gain from being part of the consortium and welcome them wholeheartedly.

More new training courses are being developed, amongst the most exciting of which are two courses for Pastoral Managers: Aspiring Pastoral Managers and New Pastoral Managers, designed to run alongside the Aspiring HoDs and New HoDs courses. They will be available in 2016-17. We are also working on a course for Senior Heads of Departments and there will be one off sessions for other groups such as the Finance Managers and Learning Facilitators.
